

Important Information

1. Only those candidates who are residents of Punjab or Union Territory of Chandigarh are eligible for seeking admission to all Undergraduate, Masters' and Diploma programmes except for MBA, M.Tech. (Remote Sensing & Geographic Information System) and self-supporting programmes for which admission will be made as per the following criteria:
 - For MBA and M.Tech. (Remote Sensing & Geographic Information System) 85% seats for state domicile candidates and 15% seats for candidates of other states.
 - In self-supporting programmes, 15% additional seats for the candidates of other states.
2. Additional counselling for admission to UG degree programmes, if needed, may be held, on the basis of the PAU Entrance Test. After exhausting the CET list, vacant seats shall be offered on All India Basis by calling applications through online mode on the basis of merit of +2 marks subject to the eligibility. Information in this regard shall be uploaded on PAU website: www.pau.edu
3. The admission to Ph.D. programmes shall be on All-India basis.
4. Candidates should reach the venue mentioned in the Admit Card at 9.00 A.M. sharp on the day of the Entrance Test. Candidates shall not be allowed to enter the Examination Centre without Admit Card and original identity proof.
5. The candidates appearing in qualifying examination in the current year can also apply for admission. The eligibility of all the candidates and the original certificates/provisional degree certificate, notification of qualifying examination will be checked at the time of counselling/verification of documents only.
6. All the candidates are required to participate in the counselling/document verification/interview process as per schedule.
7. The candidates who do not participate in the counselling/ document verification/interview will not be considered for seat allotment.
8. The allotment of seat will be rank/merit wise, considering the choice/priority of programme filled up by the candidate while participating in the counselling/document verification. If the candidate does not participate in the 1st counselling, he/she can participate in the subsequent counselling as per counselling schedule.
9. All the newly admitted candidates are required to submit their original certificates/testimonials with the concerned Dean at the time of counselling/ document verification/ interview. All required affidavits/testimonials must be strictly according to the format given in the prospectus. The affidavits/testimonials in any other format will not be considered.
10. The seats left vacant in different disciplines of Masters'/Ph.D. programmes, where there is no waiting list, may be shifted to other disciplines within a particular faculty/college. The shifting of seats in different disciplines will be decided by a committee consisting of Dean Postgraduate Studies, Dean of the concerned faculty/college, Registrar and Controller of Examinations. The vacant seats will be shifted only to those disciplines where no candidate has been admitted against reserved categories from sportspersons and Kashmiri Migrants. The committee, after assessing the availability of required facilities, will shift not more than one seat to a particular discipline. The recommendation of the committee shall be put up to the Vice Chancellor for consideration/approval.
11. The Academic Council is the supreme academic authority to frame rules and regulations, increase/decrease in admission capacity and to decide all other matters related to admissions and academic affairs.



PROSPECTUS

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12. All the programmes of the University are full-time programmes. A student, therefore, cannot take admission in more than one programme simultaneously and also cannot take up any job.
13. The admission to all programmes of the University shall be made by the Registrar, who reserves the right to cancel the admission sought by misrepresentation/concealment of facts or admission made due to error/oversight, etc.
14. The score on account of research credits/thesis evaluation/project work/final viva will not be added for calculating the percentage of marks for admission to Ph.D. programme.
15. Ph.D. admission will be made from the 2nd semester.
16. Date of entrance test/counselling/document verification/interview will not be ordinarily changed even if the University is closed on that day on any account. If any change, it will be notified on PAU website: www.pau.edu.
17. At the time of selection, the Selection Committee shall also consider the past record of the candidate regarding his/her conduct as a student in the University or elsewhere. If it is known that candidate being considered for admission has been involved in acts of indiscipline in the hostels, in the college or in organising demonstration etc., the Selection Committee may refuse admission to such a candidate and the decision of the Selection Committee shall be final. Those who have been expelled/rusticated or debarred by this University or by other Universities shall not be admitted to this University. If any student conceals his/her involvement in such activities as above at the time of submission of application for admission and later on he/she is found to be involved in acts of indiscipline etc., his/her admission shall be cancelled.
18. If a student after registration fails to attend the classes without written permission of the Dean of the college concerned for consecutive seven working days during the spell of 12 calendar days commencing from the date of registration, his/her registration shall stand automatically cancelled and the seat vacated by him/her will be offered to the next candidate on the waiting list.
19. Students should be in formal dress while in campus. They should also wear prescribed lab coat in the laboratory, required protective gears in the field and track suits on the tracks/ grounds/ gymnasium.
20. If the number of admitted candidates is less than 30% of the admission capacity in any Self-supporting programme that programme will be suspended and the application fee will be refunded to the candidates.
21. The admission to all the programmes will be through the Entrance Tests except for B.Sc. (Hons) Community Science, B.Sc. (Hons) Fashion Designing, M.Tech. (Remote Sensing & Geographic Information System), MCA, Diploma in Agriculture 2-year, Certificate Course in Early Childhood Care & Education 1-year and Certificate Course in Interior Design & Decoration 1-year.
22. No MET examination will be held if the number of applications are less than or equal to three in any of the Master's programme. If the students are admitted without MET, then the PAU Fellowship in case of such programmes will be awarded from the 2nd semester of the academic year on the basis of OCPA of the students.
23. All the students have to abide by the rules of the Punjab Agricultural University, Ludhiana.
24. Large number of fellowships/scholarships are available for meritorious undergraduate and postgraduate students.
