



The wards of faculty/staff who fulfills the above conditions may fill both the choices i.e. in campus and out campus (who have served outstation and also on main campus)

- c) If any seat remains vacant under 13 (a), it will be offered to candidate from 13 (b) and vice-versa.
14. Any seat remaining vacant among the existing seats due to the non availability of the applicant, who do not qualify the eligibility criteria under any category will be made available to general category. Additional seats for any specific category will not be made available to general category.
15. **10 percent additional seats at UG level, reserved for wards of farmers who are residents of Punjab, Subject to the fulfilment of the following parameter:**
- i) The student should have studied upto matric in a rural school situated in Punjab.
 - ii) The student should produce J form of last five years as a proof to the agriculture background of the parents or the student should produce certificate of parent(s) showing them as member of Primary Agricultural Cooperative Societies (PACS).
 - iii) The verification of rural education (Annexure XI) and rural area residence (Annexure XI-A) will be done by Tehsildar/SDM/Distt. Admin. Officer. The authenticity of rural background will also be verified by onsite visit of PAU KVK/Outstation Incharges.
 - iv) The student seeking admission in PAU under reserved category of wards of farmers would appear in Common Entrance Test (CET)/Ballawal Saunkhri Entrance Test (BSET) followed by Farming Aptitude Test (FAT). The student must score minimum 50 percent marks in Farming Aptitude Test (FAT) to become eligible for admission under this category.
 - v) The final selection in this category will be based on the merit prepared from the result of both CET/BSET and Farming Aptitude Test (FAT) and verification of rural background.
